

#### **Highlights of November's Session Meeting**

- Cents-Ability offering is divided as follows –
  1/3 our Local Free Food Pantry, 1/3 Bluffton
  Community Assistance, and 1/3 Maumee Valley
  Presbytery.
- Approved granting 3% raise to employees in 2024 to show appreciation to our valued employees and recognize that additional responsibilities have been added while we are without a pastor.
- Bluffton Presbyterian Church will soon receive a redemption payment for a 3-year CD from the Presbyterian Investment & Loan Program (PILP). Funds will be invested into BPC's Edward Jones money market account which pays better interest rates.
- Organ needed routine maintenance had not been serviced in many years. We were aware of some needed repairs and additional items found – approximately \$1000 from Memorial Fund will be used to pay this expense.

Bluffton Presbyterian Church will be hosting the Community Meal on December 21 at 6:00 p.m. We are in need of 5-6 people to help set up, serve, and clean up after the meal.
