- College ministry support
- Pastoral training, guidance, and support
- Matthew 25 mission grants
- Cost assistance for commissioners and delegates to General Assemblies
- Preserving church history through the Presbyterian Historical Society
- Administrative cost assistance for the Presbyterian Mission Agency
